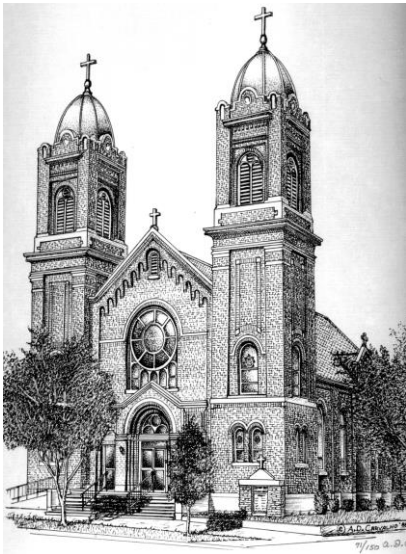

Reflection from the Pastor:

Some countries that still have monarchs make the distinction between being monarch of a country and monarch of a people. So, for example, the King of Belgium is actually titled “King of the Belgians”. Similarly, the former kings of Scotland were titled “King of the Scots” and the post-Revolutionary kings of France were titled “King of the French”. The purpose of these distinctions was to highlight the bond between the monarch and his people, rather than viewing the people as simply part of the country as a whole. But in the end, even a popular monarchy is not the same as the Kingship of Christ. Christ rules our hearts, yes, but not through force or intimidation. He rules by grace and by love. So, we can willingly join his Kingdom, or oppose him by giving aid and comfort to the enemy of humanity, the Devil. We must choose rightly then, and seek our true King.

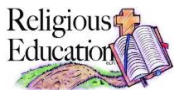

Algunos países que todavía tienen monarcas hacen la distinción entre ser monarca de un país y monarca de un pueblo. Entonces, por ejemplo, el rey de Bélgica se titula "rey de los belgas". Del mismo modo, los antiguos reyes de Escocia se titulaban "rey de los escoceses" y los reyes posrevolucionarios de Francia se titulaban "rey de los franceses". El propósito de estas distinciones era resaltar el vínculo entre el monarca y su gente, en lugar de ver a la gente como simplemente parte del país en su conjunto. Pero al final, incluso una monarquía popular no es lo mismo que el reinado de Cristo. Cristo gobierna nuestros corazones, sí, pero no a través de la fuerza o la intimidación. Él gobierna por gracia y por amor. Por lo tanto, podemos unirnos voluntariamente a su reino, o oponernos a él, brindando ayuda y consuelo al enemigo de la humanidad, el diablo. Debemos elegir correctamente entonces, y buscar a nuestro verdadero rey, Jesucristo.

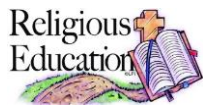
